“The gender gap in commercial real estate is narrowing, in part due to increased visibility of women’s accomplishments through programs like the SPIRE Awards.” said Linda Padilla-Smyth, 2017-18 SPIRE Awards Chair. “We are thrilled that so many companies are stepping up to recognize the women who are shaping the Orange County skyline and the way transactions are conducted.”

As one of the most recognized and attended commercial real estate awards programs in Orange County, participating in the SPIRE Awards not only elevates the status of female leadership, but helps companies frame themselves as industry leaders and supportive employers.

According to CREW Network’s 10th Annual Whitepaper titled “Closing the Gap: Addressing Gender Bias and Other Barriers for Women in Commercial Real Estate,” more than 32 percent of industry professionals surveyed reported that lack of support for women in the C-Suite and/or at home is the No. 1 reason for the aspiration gap between men and women.
